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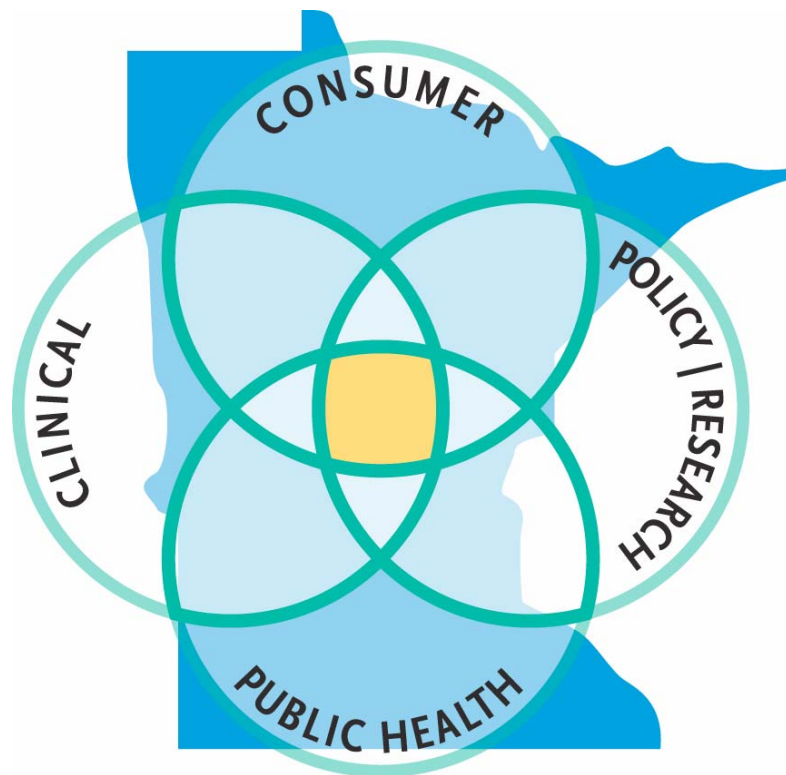

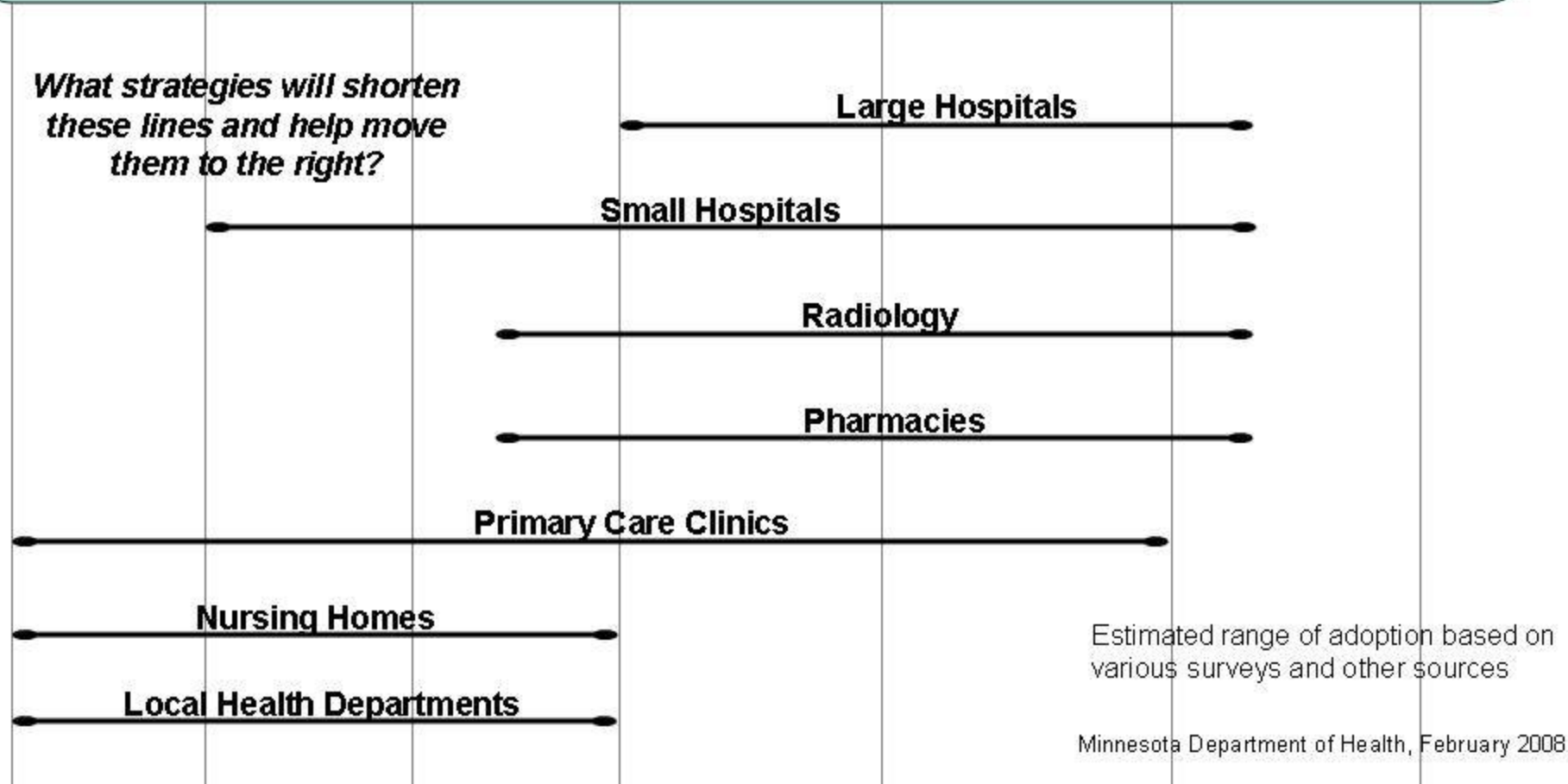
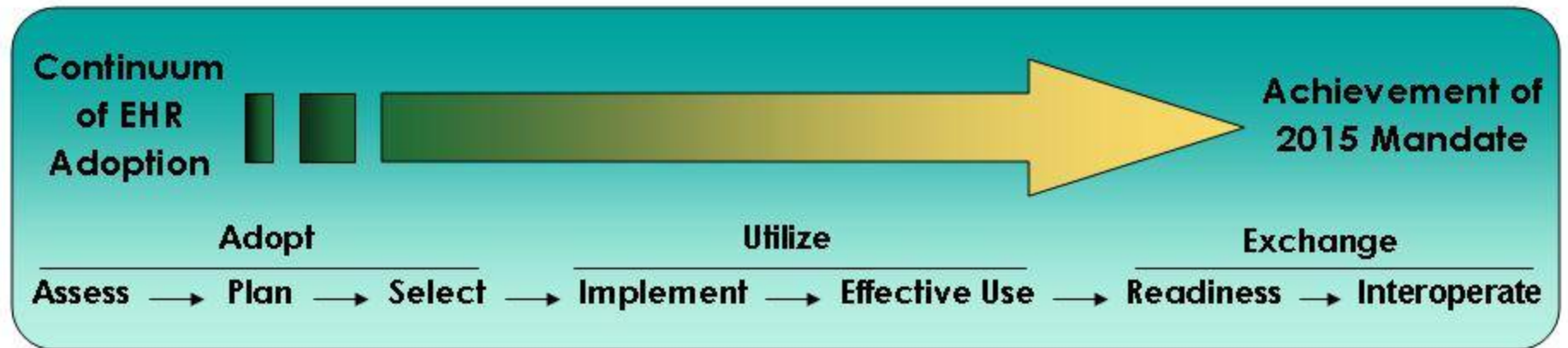


Minnesota e-Health 2007 Policy Actions

- \$14M in new legislative funding for 2008-09
 - Planning and implementation grants
 - No-interest loans
 - Rural and underserved areas
- State mandate that all healthcare providers have interoperable EHRs by 2015
- State mandated to establish health data standards by 2009
- Standard consent for disclosure form by Jan-08

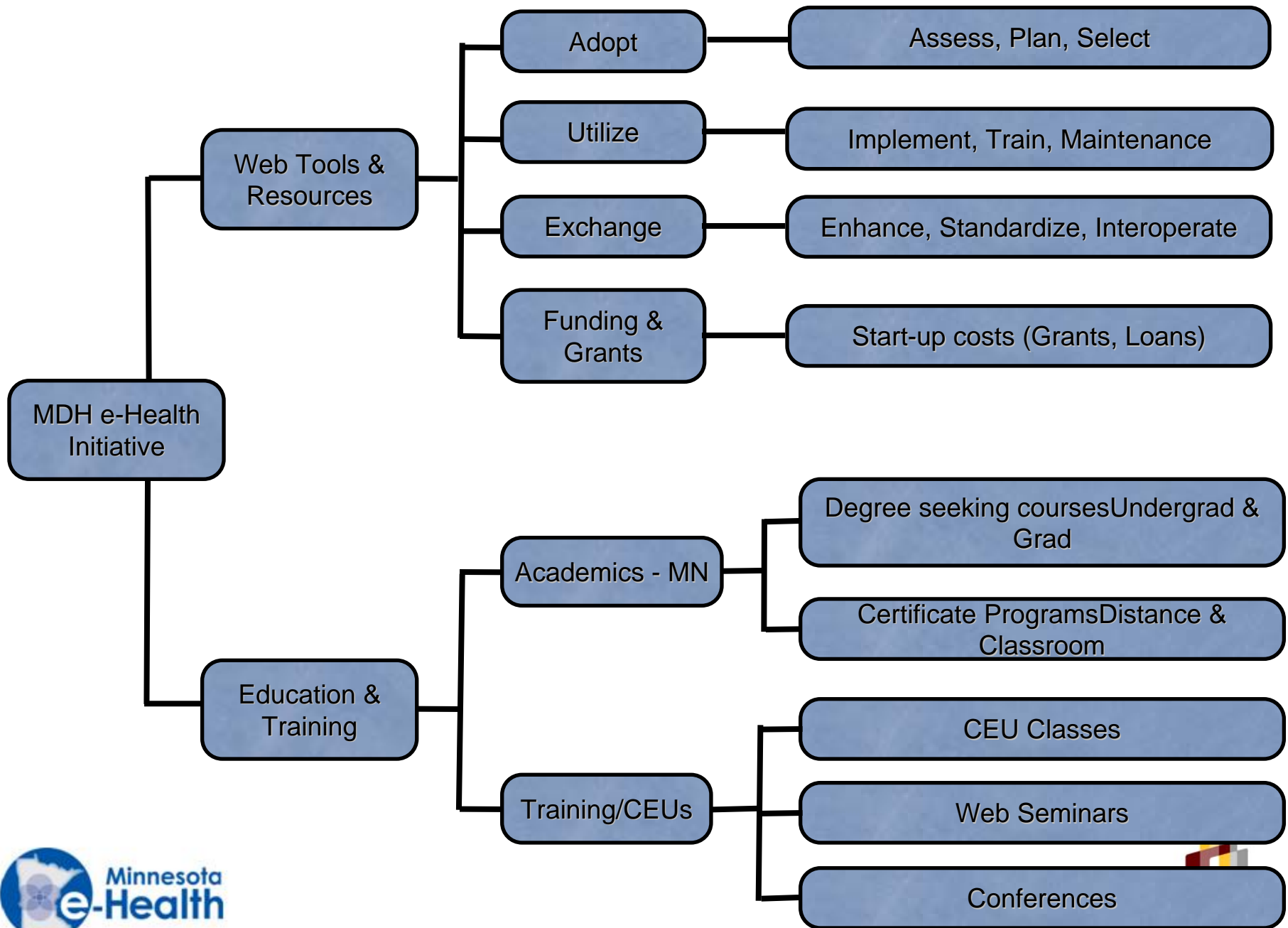

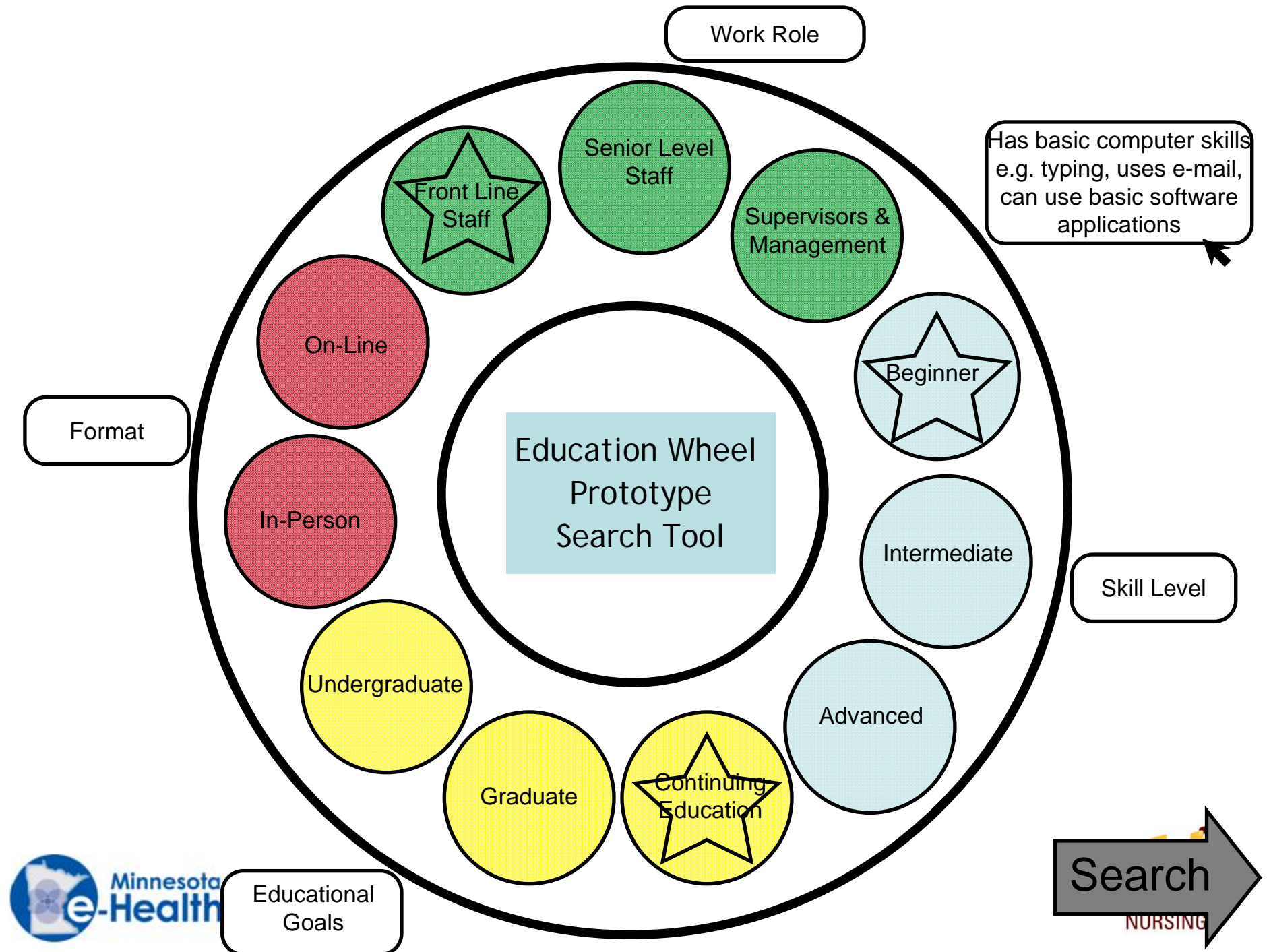

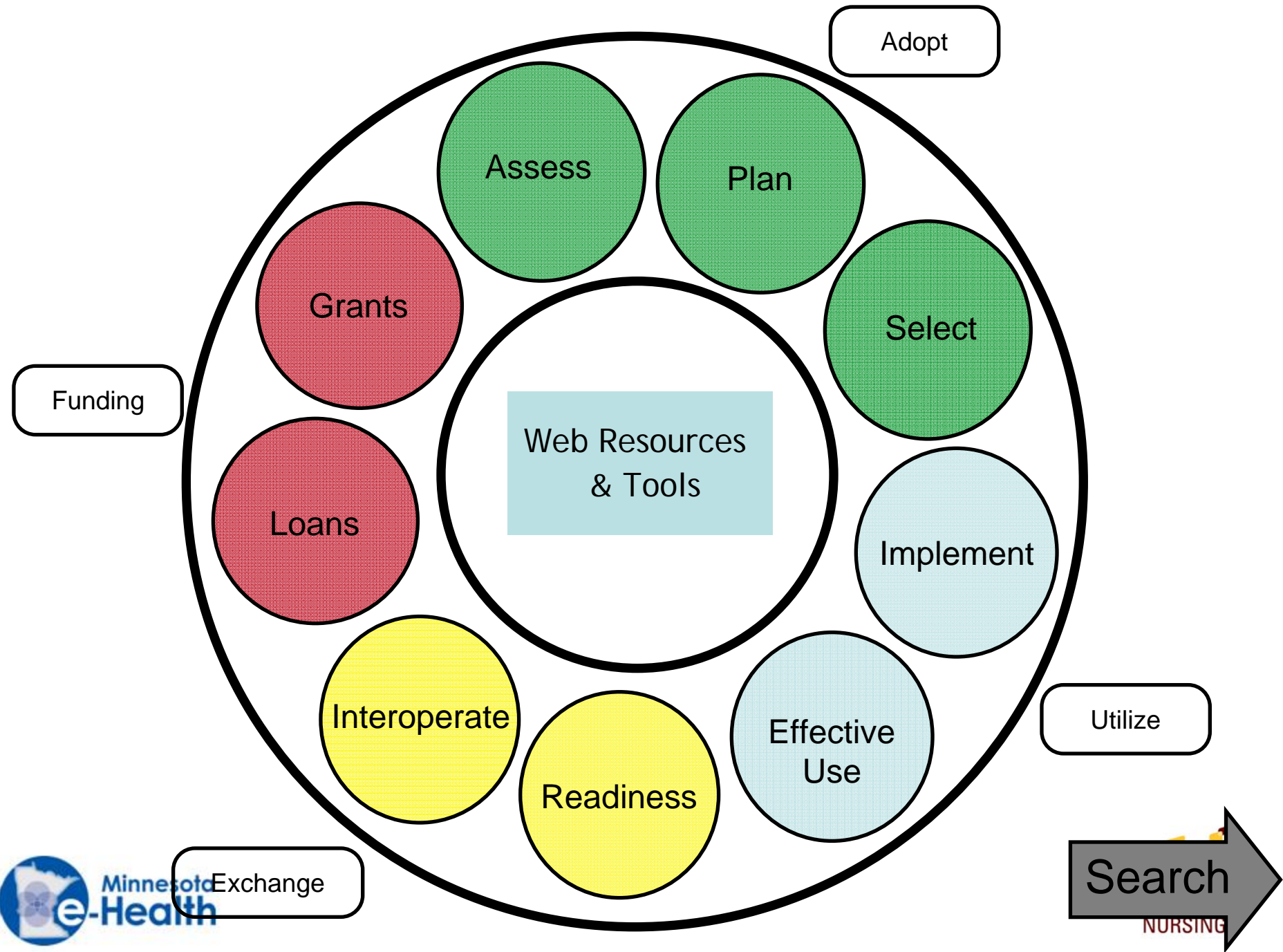

The road from startup to sustainability in health information exchange (HIE) is fraught with difficulties. Despite developing consensus that digital health care data is a good thing, it isn't yet a reality. As a result, the eHealth Initiative (eHI), through many discussions with HIE leaders, the eHI Annual Survey, and a three year grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), created the Value and Sustainability ModelSM (VSM) - a model for communities to build viable business plans and achieve sustainability in health information exchange.
